PLEASE ONLY USE ONE FORM PER HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION. Entries open one month prior to show date and must be received by the Saturday 8 days before show date (closing date). Entries will be processed on a first come first serve basis until show is full. Entry fees are refundable prior to closing date, no refund after closing date. Mail in entry forms to Dutch Mills Farm, 28410 Kunde Road, Arlington, WA 98223. Make checks payable to: Dutch Mills Farm. Management reserves the right to split or combine classes depending on entries. Ribbons awarded to 6th place. Times will be available Thursday prior to show date, after 12:30pm. Competition arena is full size (20m x 60m), outdoor with sand footing. Warm-up ring is indoor with ggt/sand-footing. Horses must be attended at all times, no dogs please. Lunging only before show starts, in warm-up arena if available. Please leave parking areas clean! Formal show attire is not required; a neat attire is expected with all riders wearing appropriate boots. All riders are encouraged to wear ASTM/SEI Certified headgear while mounted, junior riders MUST while mounted, wear ASTM/SEI Certified headgear. **NO TRAINING/SCHOOLING EQUIPMENT ALLOWED IN THE SHOW RING.**
